### Challenge: Wisconsin Talent Pipeline

Labor Demand

- Employers demand skilled workers, increasingly with credentials

- Aging population
- Inequities in postsecondary credential attainment

## Challenge: Wisconsin Talent Pipeline

Employers are looking to tap into underused labor markets.

State agencies and organizations are trying to attract workers from surrounding states to relocate to Wisconsin.



### Challenge: Concerns within Wisconsin

- Minoritized populations experience an opportunity gap:
  - Lower median wages
  - Higher poverty rates
  - Lower college credential attainment
  - Race and poverty are strongly associated
- WI 47<sup>th</sup> in terms of postsecondary completion equity (Penn, 2018)



Asset Limited Income Constrained Employed (ALICE)
(Minority= average of all populations of color)



### Effect: Concerns within WTCS

Minoritized students and staff members experience:

• Micro-aggressions, bias, isolation

Disproportionate enrollment in lower wage programs

Lower rates of program completion

• Fewer advocates, role models, and faculty with similar backgrounds

Disproportionate employment in maintenance/service positions




