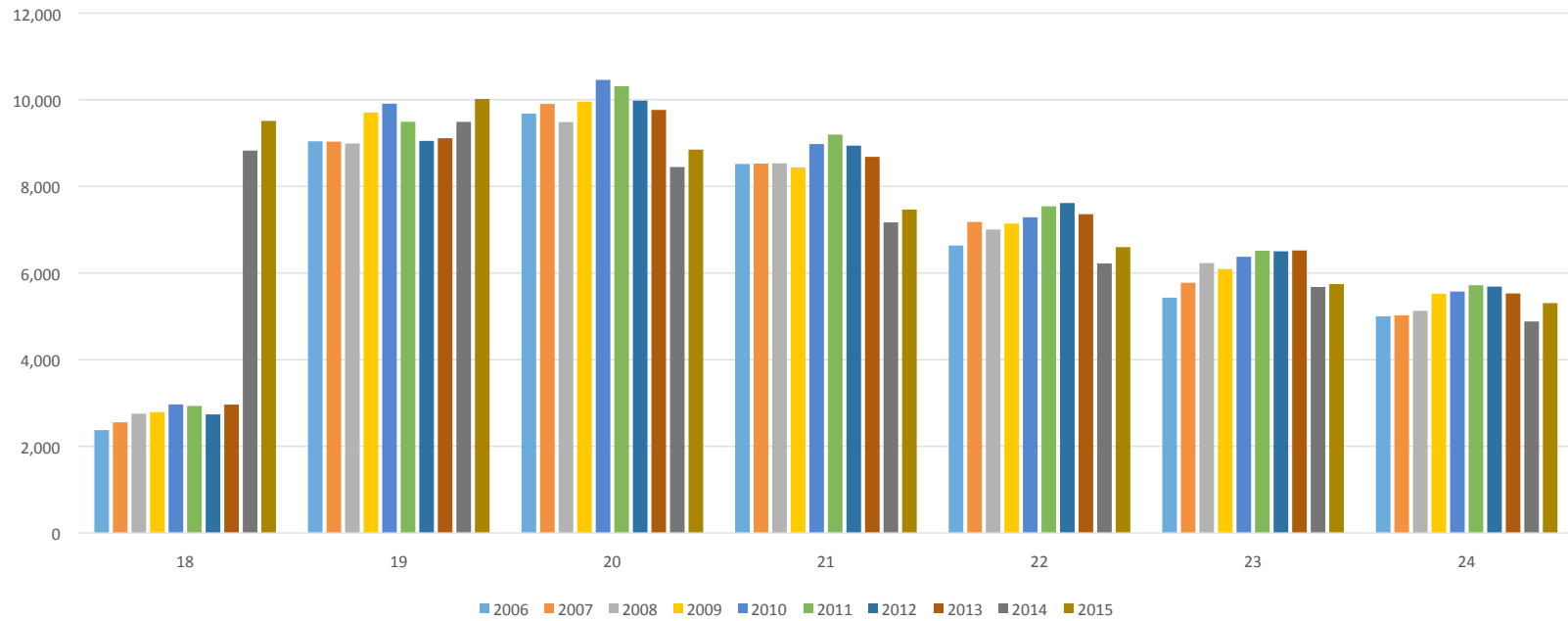

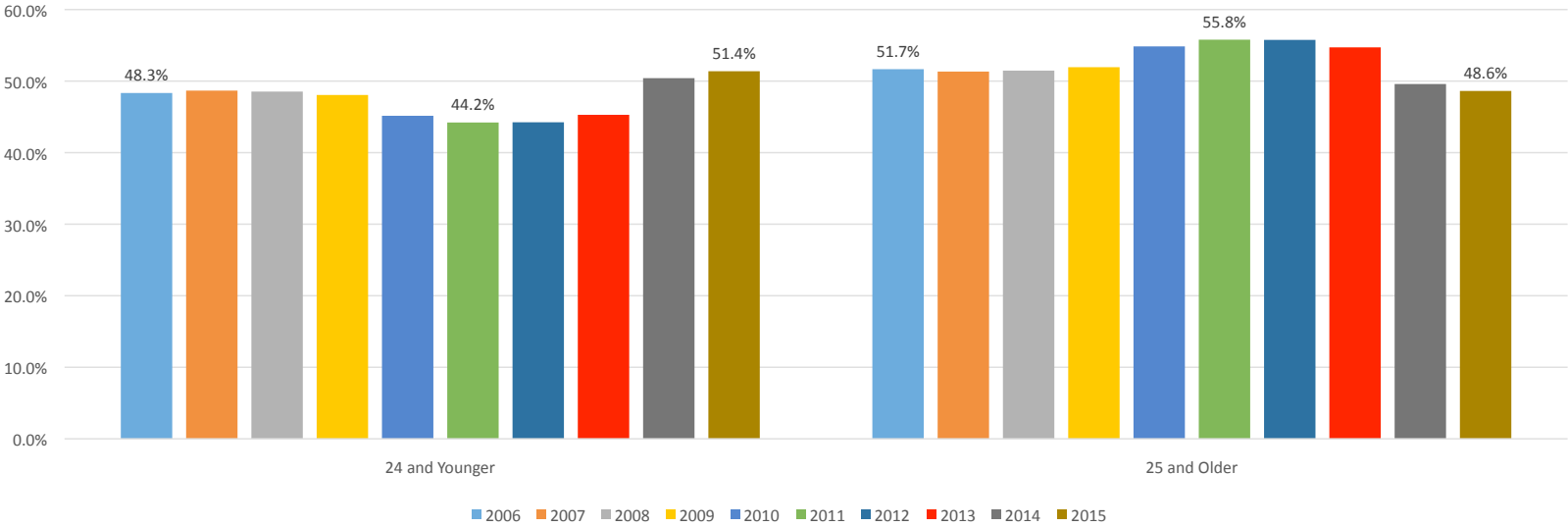

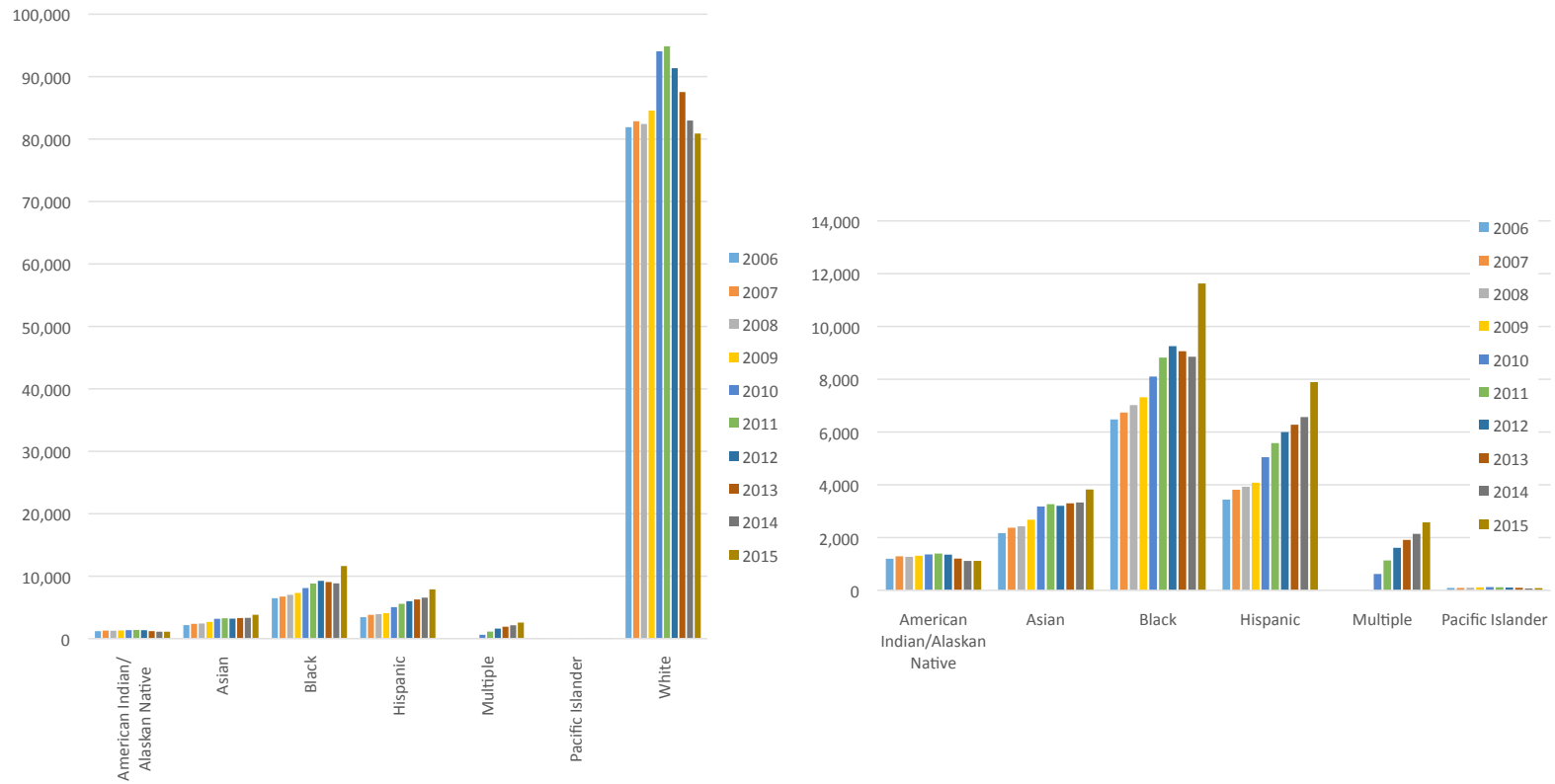
18 to 24 Year Old Program Enrollees, 2006-2015



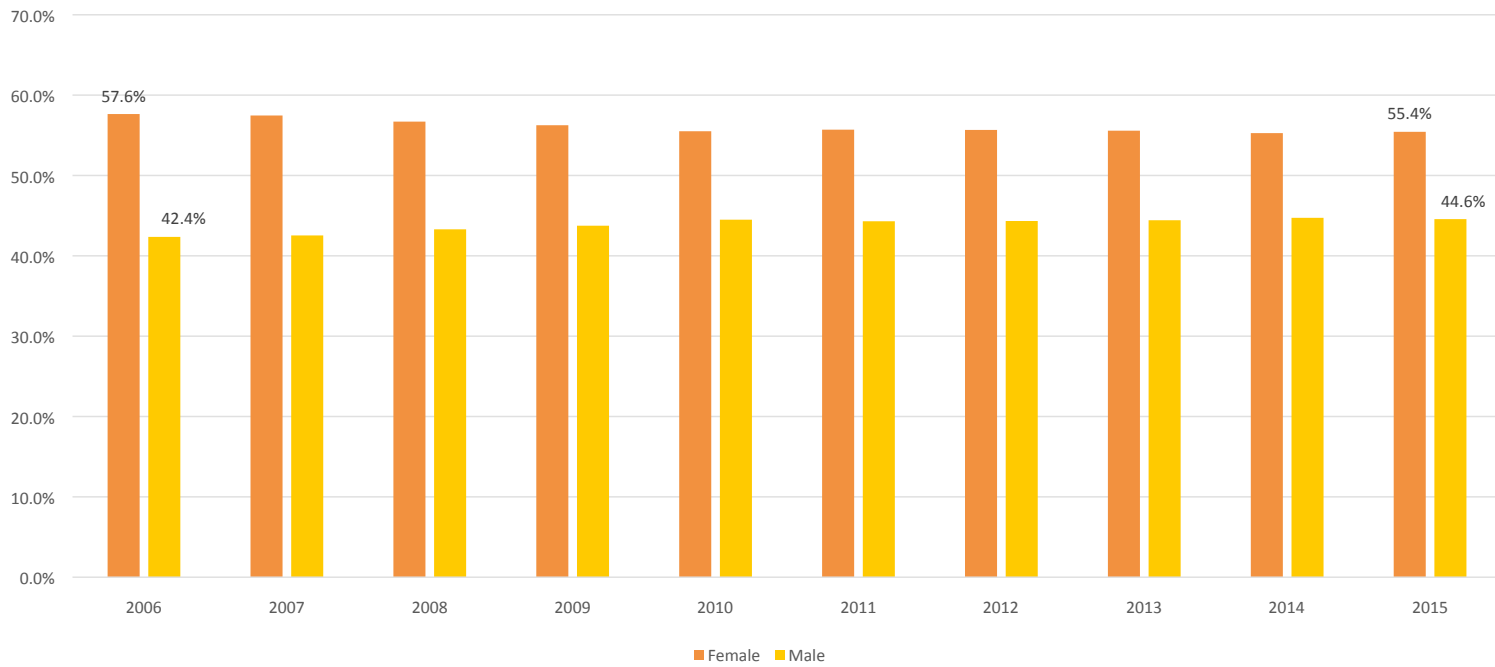
Nontraditional and Traditional Age Student Program Enrollments, 2006-2015

In summary,

- Statewide, WTCS program enrollments rose between 2008 – 2012, and they are currently declining.
- The rate of enrollment of students 18 yrs. – 20 yrs. has increased significantly within the past two years.
- Nevertheless, 51% of students are less than 24 years of age and younger. 48% of students are 25 years and older
- 55.4% of students are female. 44.6 % are male. This has been fairly consistent over the past ten years.
- WTCS program students are majority white, but there has been a decline in percentage since 2011.
- Students of color, particularly Black and Hispanic students have been generally increasing participation in WTCS programs.
