Planting


Seed is planted into "male" and "female" rows; these rows are planted at separate times to make sure the "male" pollinates at the same time the "female" produces silk.





Detasseling

Female rows are detasseled, allowing them to be pollinated by the male rows. Machines detassel mechanically followed by crews who pull the tassels missed by the machines.





Harvest

Seed is harvested on the ear, husked and hand sorted; then it is dried slowly and gently using high air volumes and low temperatures.





Flat Screen Sizing (SoftSize)

A Gentler Approach - proven better germs

Once seed is dried and shelled it is separated into 4 sizes using a "flat screen" sizing system. Flat screens as opposed to traditional round screens are gentler and provide a better quality finished product.







Treating Facility

Once seed is sized and has been quality tested it is treated and packaged into retail ready bags or boxes.

Our Treatment Facility is designed for prescription treatments with the use of precise and accurate equipment, gentle handling and fast product changeovers with the use of continuous cup elevators, high capacity handling for in season treating, and the potential to handle containers.







RIB (Refuge In A Bag)

-Seeds with genetic traits for insect protection are blended with "refuge" seeds that do not have insect protection to protect the integrity of the trait.

-This is done by carefully and accurately blending the two types of seed together.
